Animals including humans: We will learn about healthy diet, the skeleton and muscles, their function and different jobs.

Forces and magnets – We will compare how things move on different surfaces and investigate magnets.

Religious Education

Islam: Islam- learning about the life of Mohammed and how people who take part in different religions worship and what they believe.

Christianity: We will learn about Lent and the build up to Easter.

Geography

We will be learning about Mountains, how they are formed, the types of animals that live there and locating important mountain ranges from around the world.
