Science

Term I

We shall be studying light. In this topic our focus will be on the principles of light travelling in straight lines, as well as transparent, translucent and opaque materials.

Term2

We shall be studying evolution and inheritance, in particular Charles Darwin. We will focus on whether animals are adapted to suit the environment in which they live.

Computing

The children will be developing their understanding Powerpoint, Microsoft Excel, Publisher and Word. Throughout the year the children will be reminded of the rules of internet safety, and their responsibility to act in a thoughtful and secure manner.

Design Technology

The children will be researching, trying and evaluating different types of bread. Resulting in the children creating their own recipe based on those they have tried, in a 'Bake Off' style competition.

Religious Education

The children will be studying Christianity based on the Kent R.E. Syllabus. They will have the opportunity to research facts and history about the bible and understand its importance for Christians. Furthermore, understanding the main teachings of Jesus including some of the parables he taught.

Languages

The children will be broadening their French vocabulary this year. They will also develop their ability to understand new words.

Art and Design
