In the Summer of 2016 the children in Year 6 were assessed against the expectations of the new National Curriculum.

The National figure for combined expected standard (English and Maths) was 53%.

55.4% of all of our pupils achieved the combined expected standard (English and Maths) which was above the national percentage.

43% of our disadvantaged pupils achieved the combined expected standard (English and Maths).

The National figure for combined expected standard (English and Maths) for disadvantaged pupils is yet to be published.

All pupil progress is carefully monitored and reviewed in Pupil Progress Meetings six times a year, so that we can plan interventions for any pupils who need support.
