Science

In Term I, we are going to be learning about our local environment and the life within it. We will also be planting some bulbs ready to watch them develop and grow in the spring. We shall be making links with changes across seasons.

In the second term, we are going to be finding out about simple life processes: what do we need in order to survive? We are going to think about food chains and we will also be looking at healthy and unhealthy foods for humans.

Computing

During Terms I and 2 we will be learning how to use our computers quickly and efficiently and then we will become artists and create some fabulous digital artwork.

Art & Design Technology

In term I we are designing and making glove puppets and toys. Then in Term 2 we will have a go at making some traditional Swedish biscuits. We will be evaluating and thinking about what went well and what we could improve with our designs.

In Art we are going to think about colour and how we can mix colours to get both new colours and new tints and shades.

In term 2, we are going to look at the artist Jackson Pollock, and make some sculptures with clay.



Enquiry based Learning Project

In our two terms, we're going to be focusing on Science, DT and Geography.

Term I: 'The Toys are Back in Town'

What are our favourite toys and why? How have toys changed and can we design our own? <u>Term 3: 'Christmas around the world'</u> How do we celebrate Christmas in our class and how do people celebrate Christmas around the world?

Music

In music the children will be exploring music by listening to it and discussing it. We will also be doing plenty of singing to recognise what makes up a song.

History

In term I we are going to look at how toys and games have changed throughout the years and think about why that is.

In term 2 we are going to think about how celebrations and parties have changed throughout time.

Geography

The children are learning the names of the countries in the UK and locating them on a map. In term 2 the children will learn a range of comparative language in order to compare countries. They will be comparing Christmas time in European and non-European countries as well as identifying and finding out about those countries using maps and atlases.

PSHE

We will be thinking about feelings and relationships and how to manage them. We are going to think about how emotions affect us and others and what makes a good relationship and a good friend.

PE

In Terms I and 2, the children will be practising their key skills such as throwing and catching, kicking and pitching a ball or a beanbag. In indoor PE we will be learning to balance and move in interesting ways. We shall we swimming in term I.

Religious Education

In our first term, we will find out how to care for others and the world, and why it matters. In the second term, we will be questioning how and why we celebrate special and sacred times. We will also be learning about the Christmas Story and looking at ways different people do or don't celebrate Christmas.
