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Please remember that our school games kit is our Davington blue shorts and top for indoor PE and long blue/black joggers and warm top for outdoor Games. Your child will also need a pair of trainers for outside Games sessions.

Homework:

Our homework spellings will continue to be sent home on a Wednesday and returned on a Wednesday when we also have our Spelling Test.

Please can you work with your child to practise their spellings.

Reading

We ask the children who are in school to bring their reading book and reading record to school every day. They should be reading at least three times per week for around 10 minutes but daily is even better! Please make sure you record when you have heard them read in their reading record book so that they can get their Reading Rewards. If your child reads three times in a week they get a stamp and 6 stamps means they get a bronze book mark, 12 is a silver book mark and 18 is gold!

Water

It is important that children drink plenty of water throughout the day. In order to do this, children need a **named** water bottle that they can use during the day. Please make sure this does not leak and has a 'sports top' lid. These can be bought in the school office. The children are strongly encouraged to drink water, not squash.
