Science

Term 3 and 4: 'Dinosaurs' Combining geography, history and science skills to solve the question 'How did the Dinosaurs live?

Art & Design Technology

The children will develop a range of techniques using colour, line, pattern and texture. We will be exploring different techniques through our topic of Dinosaurs.

They will evaluate their ideas and think about how to improve their ideas. The children will look at different printing techniques and different forms of natural sculpture.

History

The children will learn out about the life of a significant person from their own locality. We will be finding out about the scientist Mary Anning, who grew up in Lyme Regis.

We will also be looking at a variety of timelines to see when dinosaurs lived and when they became extinct.

Geography

We will find out about the geography in our local area in term 4. We will explore the local environment and make maps of our surrounding area. The children will also use maps, atlases and aerial maps to find out about Faversham.

RE

We will be thinking about what it means to belong to a faith community, specifically Christians, Muslims and lews, their symbols and traditions. We will also be looking at welcoming a baby into each faith.

Music

The children will be singing songs and learning about how to use their voices creatively and expressively. They will experiment with beat and rhythm using drums and musical instruments.

In term 4 we will be learning basic game-playing skills, in particular throwing and catching.
