PE and Games

We have had a large amount of lost property, therefore can I remind you to please ensure that your child's PE and swimming kit are in a suitable bag and labelled clearly with their full name and class.

Homework

Thank you for your support with homework this year. Homework is given out on a Friday and should be completed and handed in by Thursday. The learning tasks sent home are set to challenge your child but also to reinforce what we are learning or going to be revisiting in class, therefore it will benefit your child to have completed these tasks.

We are putting a greater emphasis on the spelling of common exception words, simply to ensure that your child is able to use these words in their reading and writing. Spellings are given out on Fridays and then have a short test the following Friday morning.

The progress in reading this year has been very successful, however it is essential that you continue to read with your child each day and record it in their reading record. Although they have their own reading books, we understand that the children may wish to read their library books or other books that they have at home, this is absolutely fine. It is great to see so many children have a love of reading instilled in them at such a young age!
