#### **Science**

Continuing on from our work in term four, we will be investigating forces including pushes, pulls and magnetic forces. This will be followed by exploring plants. The children will be naming the different parts of the plants and finding out about pollination. Finally, we will finish the year with a topic on light. We will look at shadows and how they change in size over the day, different sources of light and how light can be reflected.

# Computing

In ICT the children will be learning to create a sequence of instructions to program a device to accomplish specific goals.

The children will use the internet to find information. We will also discuss how to use the internet safely.

# **Design Technology**

Linking closely with our Italy topic, the children will be designing and building their own pizza boxes. They will be looking at products, evaluating them and using them as a basis for their own. This will be an exciting topic and therefore we do not want to give too much away!

## **Religious Education**

The children will be learning about Judaism and linking this with our previous topics of Islam and Christianity.

## Languages

In French, the children will focus on learning simple sentences so that they can have basic conversations. We will also be learning the numbers to thirty-one and using these to write the date in French.

# **Art and Design**

Different sketching techniques will form the basis of our Art lessons in term five where we will be practising our shading and fine motor skills as part of our skill life topic. Taking inspiration from a variety of artists, the children will be drawing portraits and still life observations.

#### Geography

In Geography we will study the area Turin in Italy. We will compare it with Canterbury in terms of physical and human Geography. We will also be learning and locating the countries of Europe, allowing children to explore Atlases.

## **History**

This term we are continuing studying the Romans, focusing on Roman Britain. We are lucky to have 'Hands on History' come in for a day to deliver a variety of workshops to enhance the children's knowledge of this era.

#### Music

This term in Music will focus on different genres of music including: reggae, rap and salsa. The children will have opportunity to listen to these styles of music and explore where they originated from.

### PE

In term five, we will be studying athletics, exposing children to a range of track and field events. Indoors, we will be using yoga to improve our flexibility and balance.
