Animals including humans:

We will learn about healthy diet, the skeleton and muscles, their function and roles in the body.

Forces and magnets

We will compare how things move on different surfaces and investigate magnets.

Computing

Art & Design Technology

We will be continuing to weave using a cardboard loom to create a small bag. We will also be linking our Design and Technology to both our Science and Geography this term, using Modroc to construct mountains and volcanoes.

Term 3: 'Predators'

Combining geography and science skills to solve the question **'What would the characteristics of a predator be?'**

Term 4: 'The Bloody Battle'

Combining DT and history skills to solve the question **'Which is the best material from which to build a Roman shield?'**

Religious Education

We are investigating the importance of prayer this term, in a variety of different religious groups; Christians, Hindus and Muslims.

We will be learning about the traditions involved with prayer in the different faiths and creating our own versions of prayers.

Languages

Geography

History
