Dear Parents

New Year R Classrooms

We are pleased to see the completion of the new Year R classrooms which opened for use on Monday. This has been many years in the making but I am very pleased with the end result. We still have work happening in the car park area beyond the classroom which is fenced off so please take care when walking around.

Swimming

The pool is looking fabulous so Year I and Year 2 will start swimming this week. **Year I on Thursday and Year 2 on Friday.** Please remember to send your child in with their swimming costume and a towel, in a named waterproof bag.

DATA Collection Form

Years I to 6 will bring home a data collection form today for you to complete and return as soon as possible to ensure the details we have for you and your child are up-to-date including any medical information. Please ensure that you inform us immediately of any changes to phone numbers or contact details.

CASHLESS School - Please be aware going forward we will not be accepting cash for any items.

ParentPay **must be used** for dinner money, ASC/breakfast club, uniform or trips. Please ensure your account remains in credit at all times. In addition, we are able to take card payments at the office for uniform only.

School Dinners

If your child would like to try a school meal, please complete a menu and return to the school office as soon as possible. The cost of a school meal is £2.50 payable in advance via Parentpay.

Free School Meals

You can find out if your child is entitled to free school meals by applying via www.kent.gov.uk and complete the online facility to apply for 'Free School Meals. The online application will inform you immediately or please contact the school office.

We are a **nut free school**. This is very important as we have children with severe nut allergies. Please check the ingredients of any packed lunch items to ensure our children are safe. Any packed lunch found to contain any known nut products, will be removed for this reason.

Uniform

REMEMBER to name ALL UNIFORM including water bottles and shoes

An early reminder that boots are not part of school uniform but instead a good pair of shoes should be worn with winter uniform. All Year R, I and 2 pupils must have a pair of wellies in school as they will spend their lunchtimes playing on the lower field. Please ensure your child is wearing a school cardigan or jumper.

Children in Year R, I & 2 will need **NAMED** wellies to use at break time and lunchtime for the Autumn/Winter months.

Collection

There may be an occasion where you are unable to collect your child and send another adult. If there is a change in your child's arrangements at the end of the school day, please ensure you contact the school office in advance so that a message can be delivered to your child's class teacher. Please remain in your dedicated zone and wait for your child to be handed over to you. Whilst crossing the playgrounds, be aware of class 'trains' making their way to their collection zones.

Absence

Any absence from school should be requested in advance by writing to me by letter or email. If your child is absent at any time please ensure you call the school office before 9.30am. If we have not received a message, a phone call will be made to all points of contact to check that your child is safe and the reason for absence.

teachers to make up the full equivalent of the 5 non-contact days wholly through additional hours, or use a work in aggregate more than 1,265 hours during a school year. Schools may therefore choose to require schools as non-contact days. Schools may also require teachers to work additional hours before or after school sessions, as an alternative to full non-contact days, provided that any teacher is not required to Over a school year, pupils are required to attend for 190 days/380 sessions. In total, teachers may be required to be available for work on up to 195 days, with the additional days specified by individual mixture of additional hours and non-contact davs.
